## QUANTITATIVE RESPIRATOR FIT TESTING

Must be clean shaven upon arrival. Please turn over for details on clean shaven requirements.

If you need to meet your duty of care obligations by providing fit testing, CEG can provide this for you and your employees!

Fit testing is an important tool to ensure any respiratory protective equipment that is used as a measure to control exposure to an airborne hazard is sealed and working effectively.

This service allows employers to meet the fit-testing requirements of Australian Standard 1715:2009 Selection, use and maintenance of respiratory protective equipment and Work Health.

## Which facial hair styles may be suitable with my half face or disposable respirator?



Being clean shaven is important to achieve respiratory protection, but there are some hair styles that may be suitable.

Respirator sealing surface

If workers have any facial hair that interferes with any sealing surface area of a respirator, or long facial hair that also interferes with any valves or function of the mask, then a loose fitting head-top on a PAPR blower may need to be considered as a suitable alternative to the wearer removing interfering facial hair.
